

Directions to the Benton MacKaye Trailhead on Laurel Ridge Mountain

From the Church, go up Laurel Ridge Dr, then bear right at the fork onto Laurel Ridge Rd (a.k.a. the creek road).



Follow that road, up the paved hill, curve to the right, and you will see a grassy area on the right. If you drove, this is a good place to park.



The road will fork again, and you'll see a cabin rental sign. Stay to the right.



Keep going and you'll see a bridge.

Cross the bridge and turn left. You'll be on a gray rock trail.



There will be an orange blockade that says stay out (with the exception of hikers).



If you follow this trail about 1.75 miles, you'll get to the Benton MacKaye trail head.

This is the trailhead sign.
